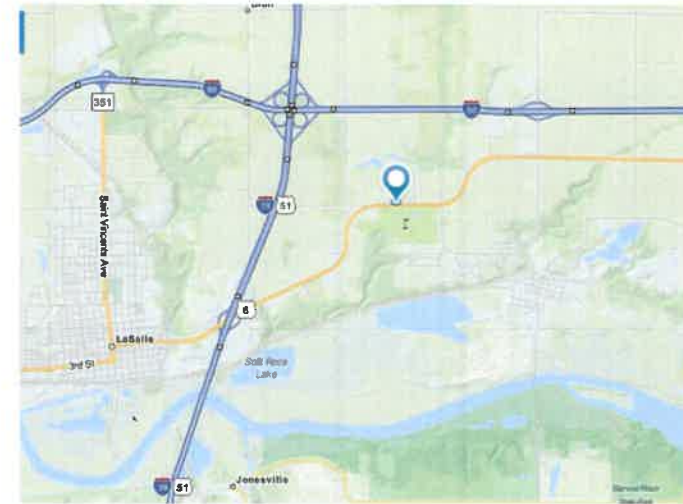

Directions from I-80: Take the IL-178 (exit 81) toward Utica/LaSalle. Turn left on IL-178/E 8<sup>th</sup> Road and continue for 0.6 miles. Turn right onto US-6 W and continue for approximately 1.5 miles. Senica's Oak Ridge will be on the left.

Directions from I-39: Take Exit 57 for US 6. Turn right onto US 6 E and continue for 2 miles. Senica's Oak Ridge will be on the right.
