A Brief Timeline of IEHA History

- 1949 A group of public health officials gather to form a professional association.
- 1950 Hold first program in Springfield, Illinois. Call themselves "Illinois Association of Sanitarians" and elect their first president.
- 1960 Became an affiliate of the National Association of Sanitarians.
- 1965 The Illinois Sanitarian Registration Act passed.
 - The National Association of Sanitarians changed its name to the National Environmental Health Association. The Illinois group followed suit and changed its name to the Illinois Environmental Health Association (IEHA).
- 1966 First Sanitarians registered by examination in Illinois.
- 1970 Initiated "Sanitarian of the Year" award. IEHA became incorporated as an Illinois not-for-profit corporation.
- 1984 Sanitarian Registration is sunsetted by the Illinois legislature.
- 1985 IEHA begins voluntary registration program.
- 1986 IEHA opens first office staffed part-time. Membership 256.
- 1987 Membership climbs to 350 after first membership drive.
- 1992 Illinois Environmental Health Practitioner Licensing Act passed by Illinois legislature.
- 1993 IEHA initiates student stipend award program.
- 1995 Licensing program for Environmental Health Practitioners.
- 1996 The National Environmental Health Association holds annual educational conference in Chicago
- 1998 IEHA initiates Tom Chojnacki NEHA Stipend Award
- 2000 IEHA celebrates 50th anniversary
- 2001 IEHA opens full-time office
- 2002 Illinois Environmental Health Practitioners Licensing Act renewed for four years.
- 2006 Illinois Environmental Health Practitioners Licensing Act extended for one year.
- 2008 Illinois Environmental Health Practitioners Licensing Act extended for ten years.
