Nature of Work

- Inspects food establishments and investigates food borne diseases
- Inspects schools, daycare centers, and long-term care facilities to assure general sanitation
- Performs lead assessment where samples are taken, reports are written and homeowners are advised on how to mitigate lead hazards
- Inspects establishments and dwelling places for health and sanitation
- Investigates and assures compliance when violations are observed.
- Inspects, consults, and educates the public on the effective control of rodents, insects, and nuisances.
- Enforces the Clean Air and Tobacco ordinances
- Inspects temporary food events and Farmers Markets
- Duties as assigned

The position requires an LEHP License and a Bachelor of Science in Environmental Health or similar degree with at least 40 hours of science courses. Certified Food Service Sanitation Manager Certificate is also required.
