TITLE: Environmental Health Inspector / Assistant Coordinator

POSITION SUMMARY:

The Environmental Health Inspector / Assistant Coordinator will conduct activities and deliver services in Environmental Health & Tobacco Prevention programs.

Environmental Health: Perform office and field work – including surveillance, education, and enforcement efforts – in relation to the regulation of food establishments, private sewage disposal, and on-site potable water protection. In addition, provide support in programs related to vector surveillance/control, solid waste, and other environmental health related fields.

Tobacco Prevention: Assist with conducting activities falling under the Illinois Tobacco Free Communities grant program. These activities include regulatory, educational, and collaborative efforts to promote tobacco prevention within the community.

REQUIREMENTS:

Candidates for this position are required to have an associate's degree or its equivalent, including a minimum of 9 credit hours of basic sciences. Preference for a bachelor's degree in Environmental Health or related field from an accredited college or university that includes a minimum of 30 semester hours, or the equivalent, of basic sciences. Preference for those with an active Illinois Environmental Health Practitioner License, or be willing to obtain. Must possess a valid Illinois drivers' license.
