Under immediate supervision, participates in preparing health and risk assessments consistent with Agency for Toxic Substances and Disease Registry (ATSDR) and USEPA protocols and conducts community involvement activities in areas where persons may be exposed to hazardous substances. Assesses past, present or potential future population exposure to hazardous substances in utilizing established or suggested standards or guidelines. Observes and assists in investigations, environmental sampling, literature reviews, and population assessments to identify specific hazards that may exist to the exposed human population as a result of exposure to hazardous substances.
