Aurora Location: The Environmental Supervisor promotes and supports population health in Kane County by providing leadership to and by overseeing daily operations and supervising a diverse team of public health professionals in the delivery of the core functions and essential services of public health. The supervisor assists the staff in achieving their competencies and professional goals; oversees and delivers services directly which include but are not limited to inspections, investigations, enforcement, and education; and oversees and delivers population level public health activities such as assessment, policy and assurance activities. Services are provided routinely during normal business hours and on weekends and evenings as needed.

Requires: Master's degree in environmental health, public health or related field. Consideration will be given to candidates with three (3) years' experience in environmental health and with a commitment to achieving a Master's Degree within four (4) years of hire; Illinois Licensure as an Environmental Health Practitioner; Three (3) years of progressively responsible experience as an Environmental Health Practitioner preferred; three (3) years of progressively responsible public health experience preferred; National Incident Management System (NIMS)/Incident Command System (ICS) 100 certification; National Incident Management System (NIMS)700 certification; /Incident Command System (ICS) 300 and 400 certification within three (3) months of employment; valid Illinois driver's license; current certificate of vehicle insurance; proficiency in basic computer skills; proficiency in use of City View and Epi Info within three (3) months; ability to work longer shifts, nights, and weekends to meet operational needs as determined by management; ability to meet the physical demands of the position.
